Rules and Regulations

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Obedience Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. In classes without a full running order dogs will be received until one hour after the commencement of judging (11am) after which no dogs will be received except under unforeseen and exceptional circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management.
3. Prize Money: 1st £5, 2nd £4, 3rd £2, Res. £1
4. The committee reserve to itself the right to refuse entries.
5. All dogs registered & resident outside the U.K. must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
6. Animals allowed in Event. No animal, other than a one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of a Dog Show during its continuance. Except any dog registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes, or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
7. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible for competition at Kennel Club Licensed Obedience Shows.
8. A dog shall be disqualified and removed from the show if it is:-
 - A) A bitch which is in season
 - B) Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease.
 - C) Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - D) Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - E) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
9. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.
10. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
11. No competitor will impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
12. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
13. All offers of sponsorship or donation must be included with the name of the sponsors.
14. The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of tenting and benching area is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
15. No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
16. Not for competition entries for dogs aged 4 calendar months and over. Dogs must be registered with their full details recorded on the entry form.
17. DOGS I CARS ON HOT DAYS. Your dog is vulnerable and at risk if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered to be slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
18. An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Registration may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Definitions of Classes. (Open Show)

1. In the following Definitions of Classes, first Prize wins in Limited and Sanction Show Obedience Classes and Open Shows confined to one breed do not count for entry in Open and Championship Obedience Classes.
2. A dog must be entered in the lowest class for which it is eligible and may also be entered in another class if desired, one special class excepted.
3. Societies may schedule classes other than those defined below. The eligibility for 'Special' classes must be defined by the society and included in the schedule. The word 'Special' must be included in the title of the class.

BEGINNERS: To compete in Beginners, an owner or handler or dog must not have won a total of two or more First prizes in Beginners Class or one First prize in any other Obedience Class (Pre-Beginners excepted).

NOVICE: For dogs that have not won two First prizes in Obedience Classes (Pre-Beginners and Beginners excepted).

CLASS 'A': For dogs which have not won three First prizes in Class 'A', 'B' and Open class 'C' in total.
